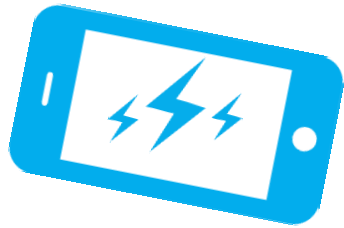
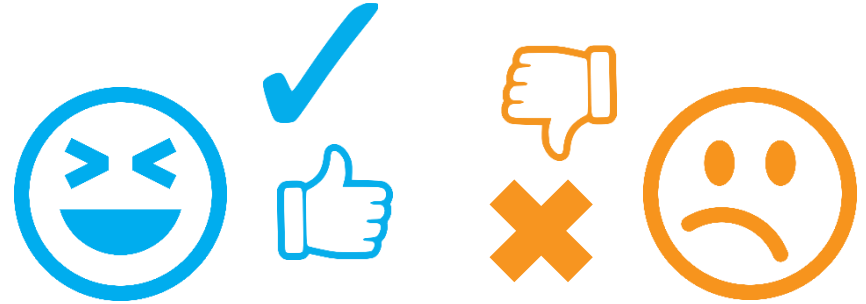

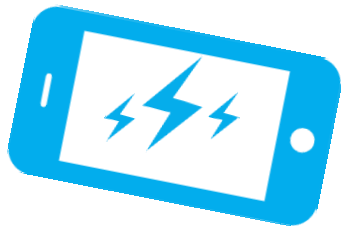
Is the internet always positive?

Five tips.....

1. Protect your online reputation

5. Acknowledge your sources
