An opportunity to take an additional National 5 subject may be possible for identified pupils, dependent on staffing and timetabling constraints. If interested, please let your Guidance teacher know.
- S5/6 pupils should choose **five** courses in S5. A minimum of **four** courses must be chosen in S6.
- If you are choosing an Advanced Higher course you should be on track to also achieve at least 5 Highers by the end of S6.
