- Also dominated by Aboyne pupils

How could we change this? I would value your thoughts: Increase school day? Informally? Clash with Active Schools? Included in those figures. Will talk to AS about how things could be improved.

Barriers – time constraints and transport. Could we ask pupils? Could netball be included in core PE to encourage girls to play in the league? Used to have seasons for sport – could we do that again? Introduce them to more sport.
