- During S3, which is the final year of your Broad General Education, you should continue to study courses across all curriculum areas.
- Four of these curriculum areas include 'core' courses which all pupils must follow.
- Applications of Maths is a highly desirable alternative to Maths for some pupils at this stage.
- You also have five choices of course from the other four curriculum areas.
